Milestones

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1935

On 25th November 1935, Axel Wilhelm Holm and Frederik Jørgen Buch founded the limited company Buch & Holm A/S.



1945

After World War II, Axel Holm was one of the first people to drive around in war torn Germany to establish contact with manufacturers of laboratory equipment.



1948

Buch & Holm started offering more advanced equipment like centrifuges from Sorvall and Beckmann.



1955

Buch & Holm set up an industrial business unit with specialty systems, glass plants, vacuum equipment, liquid pumps, autoclaves, freeze dryers, etc.



1960

Buch & Holm created a department for laboratory test equipment to test the quality of concrete and asphalt. Gravquick became a part of the department in 2003.



1970

Moving to Herlev in modern facilities with 4000 m2 under one roof with open office environment, large showroom, service dept., glassblowing, warehouse, etc.



1983

EDP (Electronic Data Processing). To optimise these processes including the entire business structure, it was decided to install a solution based on a IBM System/34 and software.



2000

Buch & Holm enter as shareholder and partner in LLG (Lab Logistics Group). Today LLG has more than 40 partners and a yearly purchase volume of more than € 100 million.



2000

Buch & Holm decided to establish a Swedish subsidiary in 2000, the same year as the Øresund Bridge was opened for traffic between Copenhagen and Malmö.



2002

CRM system based on a Lotus Notes database was used as PIM System (Product Information Management) to manage all our data.



2003

First webshop was launched, and it was extremely advanced with real-time graphic data of 8,000 products with prices, stock levels, descriptions, downloads, pictures, etc.



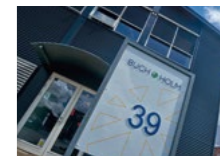
2007

Business model is reviewed, and the management group expanded with Anders Lillesø and Veljo Jovanovic as partners in the company.



2007

Most stock is moved to LLG in Cologne, Germany, and we start shipping directly from this warehouse to end users and Buch & Holm moved to new premises on the other side of the road in Herlev.



2016

Buch & Holm got certified according to three standards: Quality (ISO 9001:2015), Environmental Management (ISO 14001:2015), and Occupational Health and Safety (ISO 45001:2018).



2018

Buch & Holm becomes authorised for the installation, repair, and servicing of refrigeration systems of all sizes, and all our engineers hold Certificate D.



2024

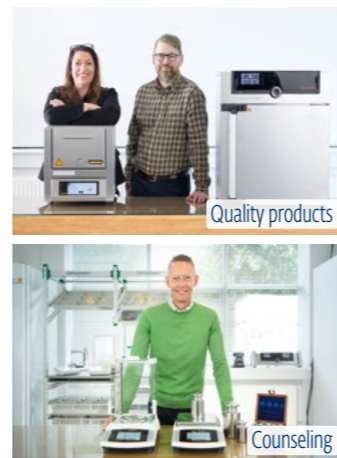

Danske Bank

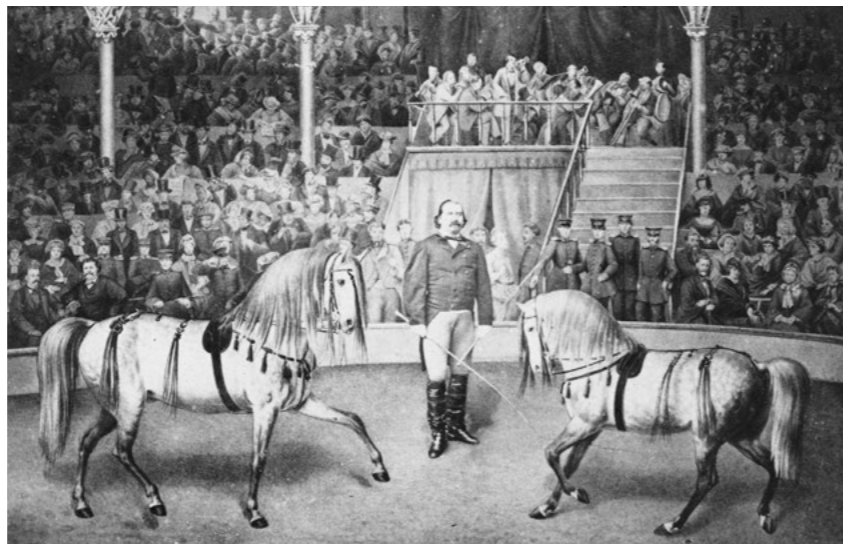


Danske Bank was founded in 1871. At the time the bank was called the Danish Farmers' Bank. The Holm family's history started with the bank 25 years later. In 1897, circus director and great-grandfather Charles Hinné passed away, and his entire fortune of DKR 789,350 was transferred from Germany to the bank. When the family founded Buch & Holm in 1935, they chose to continue the collaboration. A business relationship that is still strong 90 years later. At Danske Bank, we recognize Buch & Holm's vision of always creating increased value for the customer.

From wild horses to lab equipment

18 Axel Holm was a pragmatic young man who came out of a circus family; Hinné, and an inheritance from the circus was used to establish Buch & Holm. Circus Hinné sailed from port to port in the Baltic Sea and performed with horses, and in 1874 the family decided to settle down in Copenhagen.

They bought a property at Strandboulevarden 49 in Copenhagen and built a large indoor riding hall, where horsemanship was taught to the bourgeoisie. When the circus manager, Charles Hinné, died in 1897, the fortune amounted to DKK 789,350. The money was transferred to Den Danske Landmandsbank (The Danish Farmers' Bank) which is now known as Danske Bank (Danish Bank).



The family and Buch & Holm still use Danske Bank as their bankers today. In 1899 the property at Strandboulevarden 49, as well as the "The Riding Hall", was sold to the Finsen Institute and subsequently housed the Cancer Society until 2015 when it was sold to the Copenhagen Municipality.

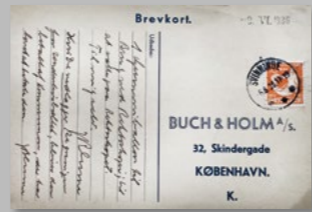

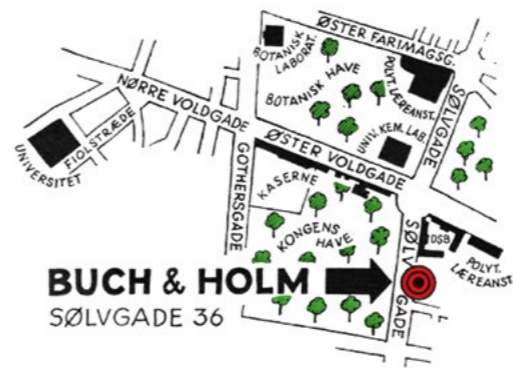


25th November 1935, Axel Wilhelm Holm and Frederik Jørgen Buch founded the limited company Buch & Holm A/S.

The two young men got in touch with each other through an advertisement in the newspaper. Frederik Jørgen Buch was looking for a business partner and co-investor to start his own business.

The company's concept was simple: import and sales of surgical instruments.

Axel Holm had been an export manager at the company Georg Jensen and was raised by a father who was a doctor, thus he had a good understanding of the products as well as the customers.



BUCH & HOLM
SØLVGADE 36

Buch & Holm was founded just after the Great Crash in 1929, and the early years were very challenging. In 1939 things took a turn for the better, and sales were going really well for Buch & Holm.

Initially Buch & Holm was situated in Skindergade 32 in the city of Copenhagen but after a few years these facilities were too small, and the company moved to Sølvgade 36.

Plymouth-sedan

This car is an old Plymouth-sedan, built in 1936. This car is the same model as Axel Holm was driving around in Germany after World

War II. We had this car on loan in 2015 where we celebrated our 80th anniversary.



Glass & Instruments



In the early days, the laboratory range was primarily glass and primitive instruments.

After World War II, Buch & Holm started offering more advanced equipment for laboratories.



1950s

22 In the 1950s, Denmark was developing from an agricultural country to an industrialised society, which marked the beginning of "The Golden Age of Capitalism". During this period, Buch & Holm established an industrial business unit with specialty systems, glass plants, vacuum equipment, liquid pumps, etc.

Vacuum equipment since 1947



In 1997, Mads Holm received an award from the company W. Edwards & Co. (London) Ltd. for being their Danish distributor for 50 years. Edwards has been a main

supplier of vacuum equipment for decades and the distributor contract was signed on 19th August 1947. We still offer a full range of vacuum equipment today.



Vacuum pumps from Vacuubrand have also been a part of our range since the 1950s and today we also offer the range from Agilent for final vacuum down to 5×10^{-12} mbar.



1960s

24 The expansion of the Danish welfare state began in earnest in the 1960s when universal welfare benefits were introduced. From 1956, all citizens over 67 years of age were entitled to a minimum state pension regardless of wealth, previous employment or income.

Denmark was thus the first country to offer universal welfare benefits, and it went so well in the 1960s, that the period became known as the Danish welfare state's Golden Age. Women's entry into the labour market led to the construction of nurseries, daycares and recreational centres, as well

as many nursing homes, hospitals and educational institutions.

Buch & Holm enjoyed golden days with surgical instruments in the mid-1960s. The range consisted mainly of surgical instruments and disposables imported in bulk and repacked into small packages. During this period, hospitals primarily used reusable instruments that were sterilised after use in large autoclaves.

From the late 1960s, plastic materials and their production methods were booming. It became

possible to replace stainless steel instruments with sterile disposable equipment. This changed the structure of our company in relation to both personnel and logistics. Wages and consumer spending grew by 75 % from 1957 to 1970.



Test equipment



Until the 1960s, Buch & Holm held an almost monopoly in the field of laboratory test equipment. Gravquick, founded in 1948,

began promoting laboratory test equipment towards the end of the 1960s. In 2003, Buch & Holm acquired the remaining assets of

Gravquick, which today operates as an active division specialising in laboratory test equipment within our portfolio.



1970s

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IN JANUARY 1970, BUCH & HOLM MOVED TO NEW AND MODERN FACILITIES WITH 4000 M2

In January 1970, Buch & Holm moved from five different locations in the inner city to one large building in Herlev, near Copenhagen.

With new and modern 4000 m2 facilities under one roof, the new building accommodated a 600 m2 open office environment, large warehouse, showroom, glassblowing workshop, sheet metal and technical service facilities, etc.

TempTator Instruments

In the beginning of the 1970s, the oil crisis hit Denmark and this increased the demand for new equipment to reduce oil consumption. Engineers at Buch & Holm developed the CA-3 combustion analyser for measuring temperature, oxygen (O₂) and carbon monoxide (CO) in flue gasses in domestic oil burners to minimise the oil consumption. From 1973, Denmark also looked at alternative energy sources, and new businesses like the windmill industry popped up. This was the start of our production of instruments branded Buch & Holm – made in Denmark.

In 1975, Buch & Holm developed and manufactured different types of our own meters under the registered trademark of TempTator. The first products included handheld digital temperature meters, and they were followed by pH meters, conductivity meters, laser equipment, flue gas meters, etc., and they were all manufactured in-house. The manufacturing continued up until the mid-1990s after which time it was no longer cost-effective.

In 1975, Buch & Holm Suppliers ApS was founded, and the company acted as the export division for the wide range of products that

Buch & Holm were developing and manufacturing in-house at the time.

Buch & Holm Norway A/S



Buch & Holm Norway was another initiative taken in the 1970s. The company was managed by Ivar Schmidh from 1974 until 1991. After 1991, Ivar Schmidt took over

all the assets under his own control. The reason why Buch & Holm pulled out of the Norwegian market was that over the years the product range and the agencies

had developed in very different directions, which meant that the synergy was no longer there.

MADS HOLM WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BIG CHANGES IN RUNNING AND DEVELOPING BUCH & HOLM IN THE 1970S AND 1980S

In the beginning of the 1980s, Mads Holm took over the management role after his father, and times were hard. In 1980, every order was handled by five female office typists, the physical stock consisted of more than 10,000 articles, and all processes were done manually.

To optimise these processes, including the entire business structure, it was decided to install an EDP (Electronic Data Processing) solution.

An IBM System/34 and software from Belgium were ordered. After four months and 20,000 order numbers entered into the system, the workload was reduced dramatically. Less manpower was now required and customer service levels improved significantly. You could keep an eye on stock levels and deliveries were much faster.

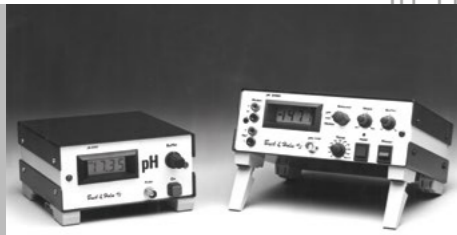

In-House Development & Manufacturing



In 1981, Buch & Holm developed, manufactured and launched the JK8100 digital pH meter. It was not the first digital pH meter, but it

was the first at a price below € 130. The product became a huge success, and sales numbers exceeded 1,000 units. The JK8100 was

followed by the conductivity meter JK8200 in 1982, the oxygen meter JK8300 in 1983 and a temperature meter JK8400 in 1984.

Electronic Data Processing



In 1983, Buch & Holm was one of the first in the industry to switch from manual systems to EDP. This was no simple matter, as only

financial standard programs were available, and company-wide ERP systems did not yet exist. The amount of data required a power-

ful mainframe computer in order to have enough disk capacity, and an IBM System/34 was chosen.



1990s

36 In 1996, Dolly was a female Finn-Dorset sheep and the first mammal that was cloned from an adult somatic cell. She was cloned by associates of the Roslin Institute in Scotland, using the process of nuclear transfer from a cell taken from a mammary gland. Her cloning proved that a cloned organism could be produced from a mature cell from a specific body part.

PCR machines

Buch & Holm started offering products for molecular biology in the 1980s. It was slow in the beginning but in early 1989 sales took off and everyone wanted a PCR

machine, also named Thermal-cycler back then. In the early 1990s, Buch & Holm sold a PCR machine a day, and in 1997 we were awarded the European

Dealer of the Year by UK Company Techné, which today a part of Cole Parmer.



Ultra Low Temperature Freezers

In the early 1990s, Buch & Holm began offering a full range of freezers and refrigerators capable of reaching temperatures as low as -86°C.

In 1998, Buch & Holm was the first company in the world to launch -80°C freezers with only one stage compressor systems, not only in Denmark, but worldwide. The first product of this kind was made by the manufacturer Danish Vestfrost based on the cooling fluid EP88. The freezers are still in our program, but are now supplied by the Danish company Nordic Lab.



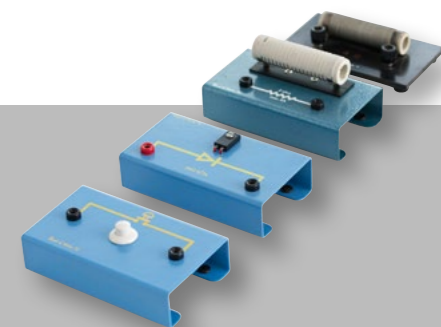

Education



From your years in school, you might still remember the physics and biology lessons. Buch & Holm was back then a big supplier

of school equipment and "Blue profiles", "Molecular Model Sets", etc. were manufactured in-house until the late 1990s.



Expansion into Sweden in 2000

38 Buch & Holm decided to establish a Swedish subsidiary in 2000, the same year as the Øresund Bridge was opened for traffic between Copenhagen and Malmö.

Our colleague, Jörgen Mattsson, started with Buch & Holm the same year, and he is still in the company. Together with Miryam Bäckström they are in charge of our Swedish operations.



First generation webshop



In 2003, Buch & Holm developed and launched its first generation webshop based on a Lotus Notes product database from IT Factory. We developed this into an

advanced PIM System (Product Information Management), ERP IBM AS400, with the program WebSmart as the overlay program. This system was extremely advanced.

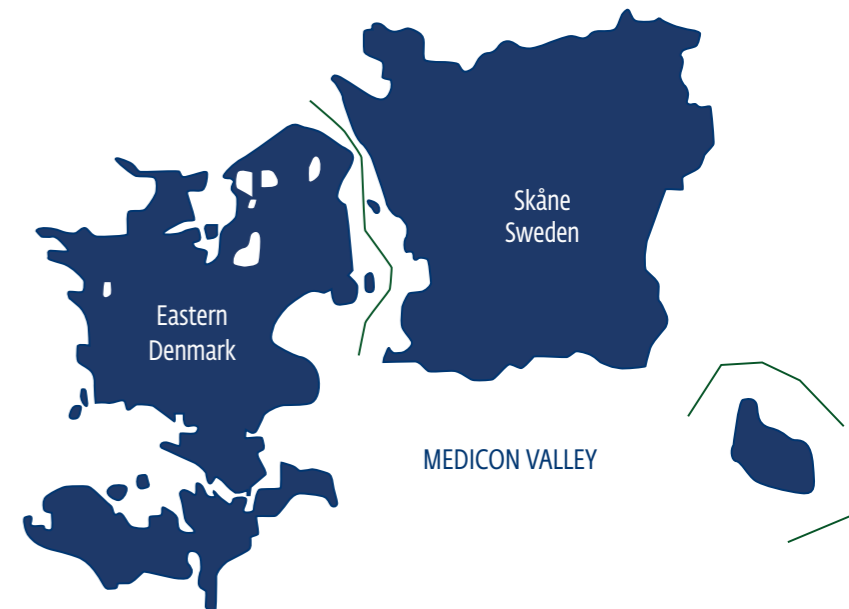
